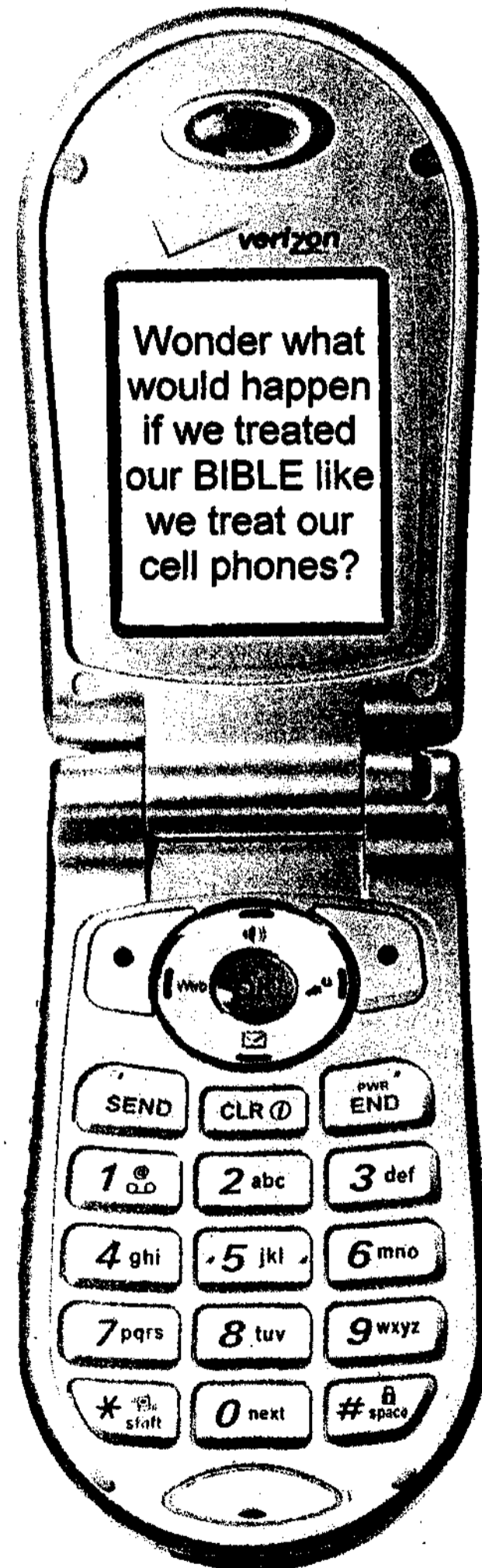


What if we carried it around in our pockets or purses?
