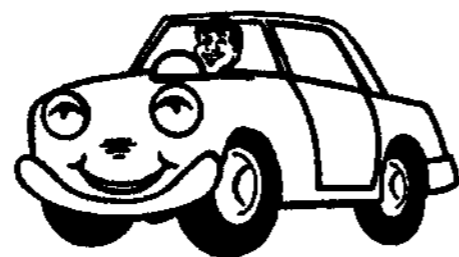


The "CAR" of Life
