## HOPE

Hope is an anchor and a helmet. Paul tells us to put on the breast-plate of faith "and for an helmet, the hope of salvation" (1 Thes. 5:8). Hope is the anchor of the soul. Many are now driven by the wild winds of the angry sea and will soon be wrecked on the rocks of the distant shore. Only a good anchor can keep them from certain death. Paul says, "...we might have a strong consolation (encouragement), who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us; which hope we have as an anchor of the soul" (Heb. 6:18, 19). "...the eye of the Lord is upon them that fear him, upon them that hope in his mercy" (Psm. 33:18).

Let us not give up but press on toward the mark of the high calling. God has given us a helmet to protect us in the battles of life. Let us not trust in our own strength. When Peter looked at the waves and took his eyes off Christ, he began to sink in the sea (Matt. 14:28-33). Jehovah says, "Fear thou not; ...be not dismayed; for I am thy God; I will strengthen thee; ...yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness" (Isa. 41:10).
