**Flee! Follow! Fight!**

A Christian lives in an evil environment. Because this is true, he is admonished to be alert, to be active. In 1 Timothy 6:6-12, this activity is expressed in three words: "flee," "follow," "fight."

**FLEE:** Our most dangerous enemy is sin. The surest safety is flight. We should flee from it as a venomous snake, or a wild boar (1 Timothy 6:9-10).

**FOLLOW:** Eagerness of desire is on the one hand if fear is on the other. We are to eagerly pursue the good things of life. Life's best prizes come as a result of earnest efforts. We are to follow after: *righteousness* (Proverbs 14:34), *godliness* (Psalm 111:9), *love* (Galatians 5:6), *patience* (Hebrews 12:1), and *meekness* (Proverbs 24:19).

**FIGHT:** The figure changes from a runner to a boxer. There are times when we have to face our foes. Our enemy is threefold: external (the world - 1 John 2:15, 16), internal (the flesh - Romans 7:21), and infernal (the devil - Genesis 3:1).

We should always flee from the presence of evil and follow after that which is good. However, if we cannot flee, we have to fight. Sometimes it is best to fight. Fight for what is right!
