### GIMMICKS? OR THE GOSPEL

"Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled" (Luke 14:23). Living in a gadget and gimmick filled world, some have the idea the church must resort to gimmicks, gadgets, and fads in order to fulfill the great commission.

Jesus rebuked those who followed Him for the loaves (John 6:26). Never did Jesus, or His apostles, dangle any gimmicks before people to coax them into the kingdom. Instead, He cautioned prospective disciples. He called attention to the difficulties of following Him (Luke 9:57-58). One of the reasons why some fall away is because they have no root (Luke 8:13). Such describes those who would be motivated by fads and gimmicks. Whatever it takes to win them, it takes to keep them.

Jesus said, "And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all peoples to Myself" (John 12:32). The crucified, buried, risen, ascended, glorified, and exalted Christ will draw. There is no greater power than that which is in the gospel of Christ (Romans 1:16). Plain, loving, and faithful preaching of the gospel will motivate people in the way the Lord desires.

The denominations see no limitations to what they can do in order to get their people to take their false doctrine to the world. And they also are not limited in what they will do to get people to hear their false doctrines. However, the New Testament church is limited. It is limited by the truth (1 Timothy 3:15). False religion is promoted by gimmicks and fads, but the Lord's church simply preaches the gospel.
