It is the group for which the Lord will return and present to the Father at the end (1 Corinthians 15:24).

FINDING HEAVEN: Wise people in ancient times looked for a city which had foundations whose builder and maker is God (Hebrews 11:10). How sad to not find heaven at the end of the way!

Friend, these things are life's discoveries. You can anchor your life and soul and hope in these precious things. They will not pass away.
