TEACH US TO PRAY

You will find that statement in Luke 11:1. Such was the request of the disciples of the Lord. This is indeed a worthy request and from this part of the book of Luke we learn some valuable lessons on the subject of prayer.

- 1. THE WORTH OF PRAYER. Notice, these have come to recognize the real value of prayer as demonstrated in the life of Jesus and also in the life of John the Baptist (Luke 11:1). They would make no request that they be taught that which would do them no good. They are convinced of the worth of prayer. Surely Daniel knew its value in far off Babylon when he prayed at the peril of his life (Daniel 6:10). He would sacrifice his physical life before he would forfeit his prayer life. Paul and Silas were well aware of its value in the midnight hours while in jail at Philippi (Acts 16:25).
- 2. THE WISH TO PRAY. These folks had a will to pray. They wanted to be men of prayer. They didn't just want what prayer offered without paying the price. We sing the song "Sweet Hour of Prayer." Such a title says we want to pray and there is something sweet and refreshing about it when we pray. Yes, there was the will and wish to pray.
- 3. THE WAY TO PRAY. These knew there was a way to pray. One doesn't just approach God in any old haphazard fashion. Didn't Jesus teach them when he said, "After this manner therefore pray ye" (Matt. 6:9)? This is exactly what these early disciples wanted to know. They saw the worth of prayer, they had a will to pray, and they wanted to do it the right way. A noble desire indeed! May it also be ours!
