God's Word Is Like Fire

Jeremiah, the weeping prophet came upon the scene in the sixth century before Christ, moved by the Holy Spirit to be a "forthteller" concerning Judah's dark days. In the midst of his sad ministry, he testified thusly regarding the word of God: "Then I said, I will not make mention of him, nor speak anymore in his name. But his word was in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones, and I was weary with forbearing, and I could not stay" (Jeremiah 20:9). Let us ask, how is God's word like a fire?

FIRE GIVES LIGHT. "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path" (Psalm 119:105). Without the word of God we would be in total spiritual darkness.

FIRE GIVES WARMTH. "Wherefore, comfort one another with these words" (1Thessalonians 4:18). The word of God has always been a source of comfort to troubled hearts. Human words so often fail; but the word of God succeeds.

FIRE PURIFIES. Nothing but the word of God can destroy the love of sin and moral corruption within the human heart. "Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you" (John 15:3). No one becomes a Christian or lives the Christian life without the word of God. Men are not Christians where the word of God has not gone.

FIRE MELTS AND HARDENS. God's word has different effects upon different hearts. Some are hardened by the gospel message while others give way to its demands. "To the one we are the savour of death unto death; and to the other the savour of life unto life" (2 Corinthians 2:16). The same message that saves is the same one that condemns.

FIRE PENETRATES. God's word penetrates. "For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart" (Hebrews 4:12).

FIRE CONSUMES. God's word will prevail in judgment. Jesus said, "He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day" (John 12:48). Someone said: "Men might put this fire down in life, but they will never put it out! Here, in judgment, or throughout all eternity."
